We were contracted by Carey Civil Engineering to undertake the foundation piling works for a new multi storey building at Royal Mint Street near Whitechapel, London.

We were contracted to install over 500nr piles, 450mm and 600mm diameter at typically 22 and 25 metres deep.

The site was highly restricted, being sandwiched between the Docklands Light Railway (DLR) viaduct and the DLR portal entrance to the underground network.

CFA, SFA and Rotary bored piling techniques were deployed using the following 6 piling rig types, Soilmec SF50, Soilmec CM50, Llamda P1050, 2nr Klemm 709 and 1nr Tescar.
