The scope of works for our Universal Piling & Geotechnical team consisted of installing sheet piled retaining walls in 4 areas, totalling 193no sheets each of which were 7m in length & were all driven to depth.

The wider project works were all completed under a 9 day blockade, out of this we had 5 days (9 Shifts) to complete the pre-bore, installation, and driving of the sheet piles.

Universal Piling & Geotechnical engaged the specialist services of our supply chain partners and our in-house expertise and plant to mobilise 5 No RRV units to the RRAP & onwards to the worksite - one of which serviced and supplied materials to the 2 groups of 2no RRV which worked together to carry out the works.
